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MINUTES 14 November 2025

The Grand County Board of Canvassers met at 12:00 p.m. in a Special Meeting on November 14, 2025. The meeting was held in person in the Grand County Commission Chambers, with hybrid virtual participation available via Zoom. It was also broadcast and saved on YouTube. Attending the meeting in person were Commission Chair Bill Winfield, Commission Vice Chair Melodie McCandless, and Commissioners Trish Hedin, Brian Martinez, Jacques Hadler and Mike McCurdy. Also attending in person were Commission Administrator Mark Tyner and Clerk/Auditor Gabriel Woytek. Commissioner Mary McGann was not in attendance.

12:00 p.m. Chair Winfield called to order the Board of Canvassers Meeting

Clerk/Auditor Woytek presented the results of the November 4, 2025 Local Special Election, which put forth to the voters Ballot Proposition 13. The Moab City Council certified the results of the Municipal General Election held at the same time on the same ballot, administered by Grand County. Fully detailed reports were included in the agenda packet.

159 Total (Non-Provisional) In-Person Ballots Cast (4% of turnout)

63.78% Total Voter Turnout

53.54% Voter Turnout from Unincorporated County Precincts Only

Results for Ballot Proposition 13:

2,479 voted YES (66.64%)

1,241 voted NO (33.36%)
